Kevin is currently the clinical and organizational ethicist at Southlake Regional Health Centre and Mackenzie Health and a freelance consultant with a number of regulatory colleges in Ontario.

He is also Co-Director in the MHSC in Bioethics at the Joint Centre for Bioethics at the University of Toronto, and Co-Chair of a national working group developing practice standards for healthcare ethicists.
